# **Shasta Watershed Conservation Group**

Looks like about 75 million in grant money for California and about 3 million in our area for Safe Harbor projects. Safe Harbor organization next meeting is in October.

## **Maintenance**

Eldon Beck said he would contact Cowley D & L to see about getting the willows sprayed along the main ditches. This fall repairs need to be done on about 4 concrete boxes that are leaking. They will need to be dug out and filled with concrete.

## **Ground Water Committee**

The ground water committee, SIGMA is now in their public outreach meeting stages. Larry Walker and Associates/U. C. Davis are putting everything together.

## **Public Records Request**

Rod has met with Dave Webb, Friends of the Shasta River, again. He was requesting additional information on APN numbers that showed the owner name with water charges. All we had was a old map with owner names and APN numbers which he did not want a copy of that map.

## **Audit**

Auditor is requesting list of assets for depreciation schedule. We where able to find depreciation schedules from 2009 to give to him. Only two items on that list haven't been fully depreciated. He needs to speak with Gary Black about current asset items from pump and fish screen projects he has managed for GID.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Emergency Regulation - Notice of Curtailment of Water Rights in Shasta River Watershed
On August 17, 2021, the State Water Resources Control Board adopted an emergency regulation
establishing drought emergency minimum flows in the Scott River and Shasta River watersheds. (Cal.
Code Regs., tit. 23, ss 875-875.9.) The regulation was reviewed and approved by the Office of
Administrative Law and went into effect upon filing with the Secretary of State August 30, 2021. The
regulation will remain in effect for one year, but could be repealed earlier if water supply conditions
improve. The State Water Board may readopt the regulation if drought conditions continue into next
year.

This order curtails Grenada Irrigation District pumping and requires them to certify they have done so. Rod Dowse provided the certification to the State Water Board. GID has been curtailed since about June 18, 2021 for low flows in the river, due to their Jr. water rights.

# Watermaster Billing

Steve Mains moved, seconded by Eldon Beck to process the 1st. half of the watermaster billing to the landowners at \$4.50 per acre by October 15, 2021 with the due date November 15, 2021. Motion carried. GID's payment to the watermaster district is due in December.
